- You must be 12 years old to participate Exceptions are made with parental permission
- Your fast begins following lunch on Friday the 23<sup>rd</sup>
- We ask that you arrive at Dreisbach at 6:00 PM and get your sleeping area settled and we will start the activities at 7:00 (if you arrive anytime between 6-7...you won't miss anything) – Need a ride? Let Kim know <u>BEFORE the 23<sup>rd</sup></u> please
- We will close on Saturday evening with dinner at 6:30 PM
- This is NOT A LOCK IN....we realize that teens and young adults have practices, games and jobs! You may come and go as needed for those commitments
- Please inform the leaders of any medications you are taking or any medical conditions that may require you to eat
- Gum and breath mints are allowed. Lollipops/Lifesavers/Jolly Ranchers is pushing it
- Drinks will be provided. Limit your caffeine Friday before the fast and Saturday after the fast. It will dehydrate you.

- Eat only a little and slowly when you break the fast. Wait a few hours then eat a little more. Otherwise, you **will** get sick or at least feel very uncomfortable.
- Dress appropriately, **yes** this is a church function, **yes** we may be outside and **yes** it will be February
- I had previously mentioned ordering "Famine" tees for any interested but we decided that the money spent on those would be better spent on our mission and service and we have approximately 100 NEW COLOR Live Generously tees that just arrived so we will have those available and fabric paints for anyone wanting to personalize them
- We will be sharing our experience the following morning after the Famine in church and will discuss who will speak, etc. during our time together Saturday
- Please bring....
  - Sleeping bag
  - Pillow
  - Air mattress if desired
  - Change of clothes wear comfy clothes throughout the event
  - Toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant (please!)
  - Bible
  - Games (electronic are ok)
  - Ipods and church appropriate music and headphones are allowed
  - Homework (if you desire to work on it)
  - Book to read (if you desire)
  - Water bottle to fill with the liquids throughout the time together please make sure your name is on the bottle!

Cell phones are allowed during free time and for your listening pleasure prior to bedtime. If this privilege is abused, we will have you place it in a basket.
