

## From Our Pastor...

### WORTHY OF YOUR CALLING

Last Saturday, we held a joint council retreat. I want to thank all the council members from both congregations who were in attendance. We had a lively and productive conversation as we were aided by a discussion of the Apostle Paul's letter to the Ephesians. At the beginning of the letter, Paul shares with the church the many blessings God has revealed to us in and through Christ. In Christ we are chosen, are destined as God's children, are bestowed with glorious grace, are lavished with redemption and forgive-ness, and are given insight and wisdom into God's eternal purpose and plan that had been hidden before the advent of Christ.

Now in Christ, we are called-called to set our hope on Christ, called to proclaim the good news of Christ, of his immeasurable saving grace that unites us into one new humanity, and called to lead a life worthy of our

calling in order to build up the body of Christ (the church) to the full stature of faith revealed in Christ.

We might ask: what does or should a life worthy of our calling in Christ look like? How are we to tell whether or not our lives are faithful to such a calling? Are we committed in thought, word and deed to God's eternal purpose revealed in Christ? Do we show a willingness to express our faith active in love, mercy and forgiveness? Do our relationships correspond to the one faith in which we are baptized? Are the "eyes of heart enlightened with God's wisdom?"

Questions like these are to be reflected upon in our shared life in the church. Is grace a constant in our discussions, discernments, and decisions? Are our differences overmatched by the gospel of Christ which breaks down walls of hostility, determined to unite us as one body, one people? Do we act as if we are marked by the Holy Spirit, an empowering and equipping presence of God's

maternal love destined to bring us to a mature faith and a moral compass bending toward justice and peace for all? Do we see ourselves clothed in the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness (4:24)?

No better time than the present to take inventory of our calling, to shake off the cobwebs of complacency and doubt, of disinterest and complaint. A time to be awakened anew into God's promise and empowerment in Christ. A time to be in step with our shared humanity and our common purpose. A time to lead a life worthy of the calling to which we have been called. Shalom!

## Clarity Prep

Clarity Prep is a non-profit, youth mentoring program that helps young athletes and other students to approach life with the attitude of a champion by overcoming obstacles and developing character.

Clarity Prep's Vision: For all children to realize their abilities and believe in their capabilities as Champions.

Dave Murray, a congregational member of Christ's United, local high school teacher, and founder and Chief Executive Officer of Clarity Prep, presented a descriptive YouTube video to CULC Council. Clarity Prep works with youth on character development. The age groups are 9 - 10, 11 - 13, and 14 - 18. He asked CULC Council's approval for using the church's small and large fellowship halls for Monday orientation sessions. He stated that

the maximum at one session will be 20 youth participants with roughly 4 adult mentors. Motion was passed to allow Clarity Prep to use the small and large fellowship halls, at CULC, on a short term basis (clarified as being for one year) on Mondays.
