We had a lively and productive conversation as we were aided by a discussion of the Apostle Paul's letter to the At the Ephesians. beginning of the letter, Paul shares with the many church the God blessings has revealed to us in and through Christ. In Christ we are chosen. are destined as God's children, are bestowed with glorious grace, are lavished with redemption and forgive-ness. and are given insight and wisdom into God's eternal purpose and plan that had been hidden before the advent of Christ.

maternal love destined to bring us to a mature faith and a moral compass bending toward justice and peace for all? Do we see ourselves clothed in the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness (4:24)?

No better time than the present to take inventory of our calling, to shake off the cobwebs of complacency and doubt, of disinterest and com-plaint. A time to be awakened anew into God's promise and empowerment in Christ. A time to be in step with our shared humanity and our common purpose. A time to lead a life worthy of the calling to which we been called. have Shalom!
