In total, 789 Seafarers Bags were loaded up into two vans to be taken to Seafarers International House in New York City. Pastor Marsh Drege and Lucas Mietlowski of the organization will deliver them to seafarers who will not be home with their loved ones for Christmas. Ten synod volunteers helped to pack the bags, collected by synod congregations, into the vans on Monday.
