PASTOR'S PARAGRAPHS

Grace and peace to you,

About a month ago in a sermon, I talked about traditions and mission and asked where you saw the church in the next year, the next five years, and the next ten years. I also asked if you are willing to change to reach a new generation with the Gospel and what tradition you are willing to give up. Since then, I have emailed a questionnaire (I will also be printing some out for those who don't have access to a computer) with different questions about worship. Also, I will say that the Holy Spirit has surely been working within the parish and in our communities! The parish has been in conversation with St. John's UCC in Mifflinburg about shared ministries. St. John's is currently without a pastor, and in our discussions, we talked about what worship opportunities could look like for us. After further discussion, the parish council and the congregational councils from Christ's United and First Lutheran agreed and voted to move forward with the following pastoral care needs and worship opportunities with St. John's UCC in Mifflinburg:

- This agreement will begin with a six-month trial starting January 1, 2025.
- I will preach and preside on the second Sunday of each month at St. John's UCC at 10:30 a.m. This will be a combined worship where the congregation of First Lutheran will worship at St. John's UCC in Mifflinburg.
- I will be on call for any pastoral care needs for St. John's and preside at funerals and weddings.
- A quarterly combined worship service will be held at Christ's United at 10:30 a.m. followed by a lunch. The parish council will set those dates.
- After the 6-month trial, the agreement can be extended, or the Buffalo Valley Lutheran Parish and/or St. John's UCC can end the agreement. St. John's UCC will compensate the Buffalo Valley Lutheran Parish for my services.

I think this will be an excellent opportunity for us as a community of faith. If you have any questions, please let me know! I continue to lift you all up in prayer.
